for holding the International Tournament AGT & KMWf ATLANTS
in Mas-wrestling (Tayaq tartu) among students and children
under the auspices of AGT Global
June 24–26, 2026
Astana, Republic of Kazakhstan**

Astana 2026

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1. Goals and Objectives:

Mas-wrestling (Tayaq tartu) is a contest of spirit, strength, and respect, where not only physical power matters, but also endurance, concentration, and respect for one's opponent. Originating from the depths of national culture, this sport today is becoming a global symbol of sporting unity and fair competition. **Tayaq Tartu / Mas-wrestling** is the energy of tradition and the strength of the nation.

The organizers of the tournament — **AGT GLOBAL** — view sport not only as competition, but also as a powerful instrument for educating strong, healthy, and goal-oriented youth. The company's initiative brings together sport, education, and cultural diplomacy, creating conditions for international cooperation between universities and sports organizations.

AGT GLOBAL: Sport as a Strategy for the Future.

For children and universities/colleges, participation in the tournament provides an opportunity to:

- demonstrate the level of athletic training and team spirit of students, as well as competitive experience and victory in the sports arena for children;
- implement youth projects aimed at the development of sport and a healthy lifestyle;
- strengthen international cooperation in the fields of sport and education;
- become part of a global movement for the formation of a strong and healthy nation;
- contribute to the future of children — to a generation capable of winning and inspiring.

The tournament is held with the aim of promoting a national sport and pursues the following objectives:

- strengthening friendly sporting ties between students and children from different countries;
- popularization and promotion of Mas-Wrestling (Tayaq Tartu) among students and children;
- identification of the strongest student and child athletes in Mas-Wrestling (Tayaq Tartu);
- supporting talented students and children in their development into professional Mas-Wrestling (Tayaq Tartu) athletes;
- gaining international recognition and visibility, as well as the opportunity in the future to become part of the professional athletes of the federation;
- development of mass and professional student and children's sport as an element of cultural and educational work with the younger generation;
- increasing competitiveness among national sports, fostering champions among student and child Mas-Wrestling (Tayaq Tartu) athletes;
- providing opportunities for professional employment, including becoming a coach, personal development, and earning income.

The **International Tournament AGT & KMWF ATLANTS in Mas-Wrestling (Tayaq Tartu) among students and children** (hereinafter referred to as the

Tournament) is held in accordance with the **Calendar Plan of Sports Events of the International Mas-Wrestling Federation for 2026** and the **Unified Calendar Plan of the Republican Federation of Mas-Wrestling of Kazakhstan for 2026**.

2. Dates and Venue

The **International Tournament AGT & KMWF ATLANTS in Mas-Wrestling (Tayaq Tartu)** among students and children will be held from **June 24 to June 26, 2026**, in the city of **Astana (Kazakhstan)**, on the premises of the «**S. Seifullin Kazakh Agrotechnical Research University**» (Republic of Kazakhstan, 010011, Astana, Zhenis Avenue, 62).

Arrival days: June 22–23, 2026

Departure day: June 27, 2026

Arrival, accommodation, and meals of the tournament participants shall be provided at their own expense or at the expense of the sending organizations.

3. Competition Management

The overall management of the preparation and conduct of the competition is carried out by AGT Global and the Republican Federation of Mas-Wrestling (Tayaq Tartu).

The direct organization and conduct of the competition are entrusted to the Organizing Committee and the Main Panel of Judges, approved by the Republican Federation of Mas-Wrestling (Tayaq Tartu) and its representative office in the city of Astana.

4. Conditions of Participation

The following athletes are eligible to participate in the competition:

- **Boys and girls aged 12–14** (the athlete must have reached the age of 12 no later than one day before the start of the competition);

- **Boys and girls aged 15–17** (the athlete must reach the established age within the calendar year of the competition);

- **Students:**

- senior boys and girls aged **15–17** (the athlete must reach the established age within the calendar year of the competition);

- students — **men and women aged 18–25** (the athlete must have reached the age of 18 no later than one day before the start of the competition),

provided that they have passed a medical examination and have no contraindications for participation in strength sports. Participation is allowed upon submission of an official entry from a national or regional federation or from an educational institution, signed by the head of the organization.

For participation in the competition, national and regional federations are entitled to nominate **one referee** of the appropriate refereeing category to work as part of the competition's judging panel.

Team composition from a region:

- 1 (one) athlete per weight category;
- 1 coach–representative;

- 1 referee.

Participants are required to compete in sportswear in accordance with the rules of the International Mas-Wrestling Federation, namely: red or blue Mas-Wrestling shorts (as determined by the draw) and sports footwear without spikes, with a soft sole.

National sports ceremonial uniforms with the logos of universities, event organizers, or sponsoring organizations are permitted.

By participating in the tournaments, athletes grant the organizers the right to photograph, video record, and otherwise use their image, voice, appearance, and name. The organizers shall have the copyright to display, distribute, and otherwise use these materials for merchandising, promotion, and advertising purposes aimed at popularizing this sport, in any currently existing or future mass media, social media channels, and websites. These rights are granted in perpetuity and without additional compensation, in favor of the tournament organizers.

5. Conditions for Conducting the Competition

The competition is of an initiative nature and is conducted in full compliance with the rules and policies of the International Mas-Wrestling Federation.

Depending on the number of participants in each weight category, the competition system may be adjusted in accordance with the competition rules, as follows:

- for 7 or more athletes in a weight category — a double-elimination system (elimination after two losses), with division into Group «A» and Group «B»;
- for 6, 5, 4, or 3 athletes in a weight category — a round-robin system;
- for 2 or fewer athletes in a weight category — the weight category shall be merged with the next higher weight category.

The Mas-Wrestling (Tayaq Tartu) tournament is held in the following weight categories:

- Boys aged 12–14: 40 kg, 45 kg, 50 kg, 60 kg;
- Girls aged 12–14: 40 kg, 45 kg, 50 kg, 60 kg;
- Students – senior boys aged 15–17: 60 kg, 70 kg, 80 kg, 80+ kg;
- Students – senior girls aged 15–17: 50 kg, 60 kg, 70 kg, 70+ kg;
- Students aged 18–25 – men: 60 kg, 70 kg, 80 kg, 80+ kg;
- Students aged 18–25 – women: 55 kg, 65 kg, 75 kg, 75+ kg.

Final results (official protocols), in both hard copy and electronic form, shall be submitted to the organizers and to the Republican Federation of Mas-Wrestling (Tayaq Tartu) within two weeks from the date of completion of the competition.

6. Participant Insurance

Participation in the competition is permitted only upon submission of the original life and health accident insurance policy for each participant, which must be presented to the registration and accreditation commission.

Participant insurance shall be provided at the expense of the sending organizations.

7. Safety and Security

Competitions shall be held at sports facilities that comply with the requirements of the relevant regulatory legal acts in force in the Republic of Kazakhstan and aimed at ensuring public order and the safety of participants and spectators, subject to the availability of duly approved certificates confirming the readiness of the sports facilities for hosting such events.

Qualified medical personnel shall be present at the competition venues.

8. Financing

All expenses related to the preparation, organization, and conduct of the competition shall be borne by the Organizing Committee of AGT Global and the Republican Federation of Mas-wrestling (Tayaq Tartu).

Expenses related to travel, accommodation, meals, and insurance of athletes, coaches, and team representatives shall be covered by the sending organizations.

9. Awarding

Participants who place 1st, 2nd, and two 3rd places in each weight category shall be awarded diplomas, medals, and tournament cups.

10. Applications for Participation

Preliminary applications from colleges/universities or regional federations, indicating the number of arriving athletes, coaches, and team representatives, must be submitted by March 25, 2026 to the organizers' contact details or by e-mail: agttayagtartu@gmail.com.

Participant registration is also carried out additionally through the official tournament website at <https://agtglobal.kz/>, as provided by the organizers.

The final application shall be submitted by a federation representative to the Organizing Committee on the official arrival day.

The registration and accreditation commission shall be provided with applications signed by the head of the regional federation and a medical doctor, as well as the following documents for each athlete:

- passport / identity card;
- life and health accident insurance policy (original);
- medical certificate with a physician's clearance for participation in the competition;
- student ID card or academic record book.

Delegations from countries requiring a visa to enter the territory of the Republic of Kazakhstan must submit to the tournament organizers, in advance, a list of participants with complete and detailed information. The participant accreditation commission must also be provided with the national flag of the country (size 100 × 150 cm, vertical format) and the national anthem in a shortened version (one verse and chorus) in electronic format.

11. Marketing and Promotion

The Organizing Committee of AGT Global and the Republican Federation of Mas-Wrestling (Tayaq Tartu), within the framework of concluded and duly executed agreements, shall jointly undertake actions to ensure activities related to the attraction of sponsors and partners, as well as the protection and observance of their rights.

These activities shall be carried out in compliance with the marketing guidelines and policies of the Republican Federation of Mas-Wrestling (Tayaq Tartu), without limitation thereto.

12. Media

The Organizing Committee guarantees the provision of appropriate working conditions at the event for accredited media representatives, in accordance with the Media Guidelines of the Republican Federation of Mas-Wrestling (Tayaq Tartu).

This program serves as the official invitation to the competition.
